Day Three : Activities in Delhi
Visit Old and New Delhi

"Old Delhi" was an ancient walled city. Mughal Emperor Shah Jehan in 1650 switched the Mughal capital from Agra to Delhi. Shah Jehan possessing an exquisite talent, especially in architecture, created the seventh city and in the process brought about Delhi's glorious renaissance, you will see Red Fort , Jama Masjid and Chandni Chowk. Take a Rickshaw ride through the narrow lanes of Chandni Chowk to get a feel of the royal life of the Mughal emperors.

Post Lunch visit "New Delhi" which came into existence much later, and is also known as Lutyens Delhi. Visit some most famous places of Delhi like Qutab Minar - which is the tallest brick minaret in the world, Humayun's Tomb - the first significant example of the Mughal architecture with high arches and double dome, India Gate – a war memorial which was built to salute the brave Indian soldiers of the British Army who lost their lives in World War 1, bypass President's House and the Parliament Street .
