

6 Nights Incentive Trip to Incredible India: Delhi – Agra – Jaipur – Delhi



Day One
Arrive Delhi: The Capital of India

Upon arrival in Delhi International Airport you are met by our Company's executive and transferred to your pre-booked hotel. Delhi, the capital of India, is a perfect amalgamation of old times and modern India.

Welcome Dinner at hotel.

Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Delhi.

Day Two:
Visit Old Delhi and Akshardham Temple

"Old Delhi" was an ancient walled city. Mughal Emperor Shah Jehan moved the capital from Agra to Delhi in 1650. You will see the Red Fort, Jama Masjid and Chandni Chowk. Take a rickshaw ride through the narrow lanes of Chandni Chowk to get a feel of the royal life of the Mughal emperors.

Post Lunch visit Akshardham Temple: Witness the heritage of India in all its facets, insights and beauty at the Swaminarayan Akshardham through its mandir, exhibitions and verdant gardens.

Dinner at Chor Bizarre and overnight stay at the hotel in Delhi.



Day Three
Visit New Delhi and Lotus (Bahai) Temple

"New Delhi" which came into existence much later, and is also known as "Lutyens Delhi".

Visit some of the most famous places in Delhi such as Qutab Minar, which is the tallest brick minaret in the world, Humayun's Tomb, a significant example of the Mughal architecture, India Gate, a war memorial which was built to salute the Indian soldiers of the British Army who lost their lives in World War 1, bypass President's House and the Parliament Street.

Post lunch visit the Lotus Temple – "A Place for Unity and Worship where all are welcome". It is a unique Lotus flower shape Bahai Temple thus making it a prominent attraction in Delhi.

Dinner at Park Balluchi, located in the middle of Deer Park and surrounded by forest and manicured lawns. Overnight stay at the Hotel in Delhi.



Day Four
Delhi – Agra (205 kms, 4 hrs drive)

After early breakfast at the hotel leave by private coach for Agra, the Mughal City. Upon arrival in Agra check-in at your pre-booked hotel. Later visit the Red Fort, built near the gardens of the Taj Mahal. Agra Fort was also the headquarters for the Mughal Emperor Shah Jehan.

Enjoy lunch at the ITC Maurya. After lunch visit the famous Taj Mahal: Taj Mahal is one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World. Built in 1652 by Emperor Shah Jehan in memory of his loving wife Mumtaz Mahal, the Taj Mahal was built in white marble and took 22 years to build by 20,000 skilled artisans. The building's stupendous scale, flawless symmetry, translucent white marble and shimmering reflection in the water channel are truly breathtaking.

Optional:- Evening - Mohabbat the Taj
Enjoy the Cultural Show "Mohabbat the Taj" at Kalakirti Cultural and Convention Centre (80 minutes duration). In this show the complete story behind the Taj is narrated. Dinner with Indian cultural performances.

Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Agra.

Day Five

Agra – Jaipur (250 Kms, 5 hrs drive)

Jaipur: The Pink City of Rajasthan

Very early morning an optional visit to the Famous Taj Mahal at sunrise. Return to hotel for breakfast.

After breakfast leave by coach for Jaipur – the Pink City. En-route visit The Fatehpursikri, a World heritage site built by Akbar. It boasts several palaces, Masjids and large halls in typical Mughal architecture.

Upon arrival in Jaipur check-in at your pre-booked hotel.

Evening at leisure to enjoy the rich culture, heritage and hospitality of India.

Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Jaipur.

Day Six

Jaipur: excursion to Amber Fort

This morning we visit the Amber Fort on the Aravali Hills with elephant ride.

Visit the Sheesh Mahal or the Hall of Victory glittering with the mirrors in the Fort. A slow elephant ride up to the Entrances of the Fort.

Afternoon tour of City Palace and Observatory. The City Palace in the heart of the old city is a blend of Rajput and Mughal architecture. The complex has a variety of courtyards, gardens and buildings. The Palace of Winds, also known as Hawa Mahal, is a five-storey structure of pink sandstone has semi-octagonal and delicately honeycombed windows overlooking the main street of the old city. It was originally built to enable the ladies of the Royal household to watch everyday life.

Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Jaipur

Day Seven

Jaipur – Delhi (260 kms, 5 hrs drive)

After breakfast leave for Delhi by private coach, arrive in Delhi and join for an early dinner at the Olive Bar & Kitchen, to share the group's experience of Incredible India.

Later drop at Delhi airport to board your return flight home.
